COMENIUS experience in Belgium, November 2014

The trip in Belgium for the project Comenius-Spuren was one of the most expansive and consolidating experiences I've ever done. This is thanks to the possibility of an open-mindedness to new traditions and cultures which has given me a wider knowledge of other European schools, countries and people. Based on the topic "Proverbs", it was interesting to study them as a "life lesson" and I was also able to observe the painting "Bruegel Proverbs" about the Topic in the museum of Antwerp. I had the opportunity to visit a school in Gand and noticed the differences with our Cagliari school; this allowed me to appreciate our technology of electronic whiteboards in the classrooms, but also their manual activity, characterized by the processing of copper, from sculptures and objects of wood or other expanded disciplines such as art and music.
