## Frankfurt



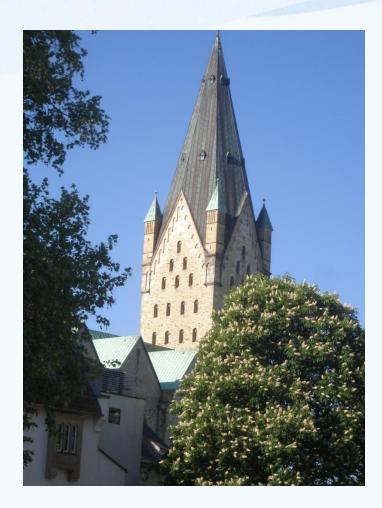
